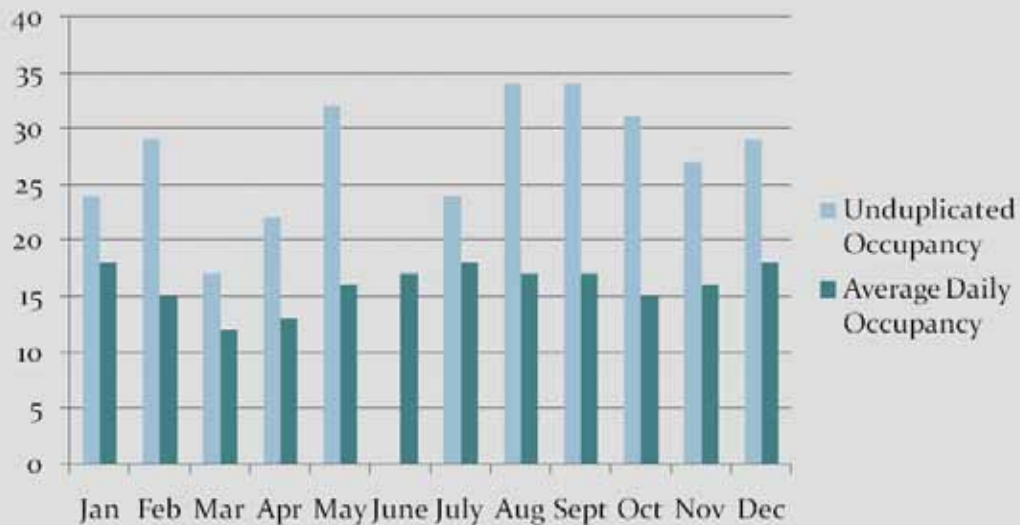

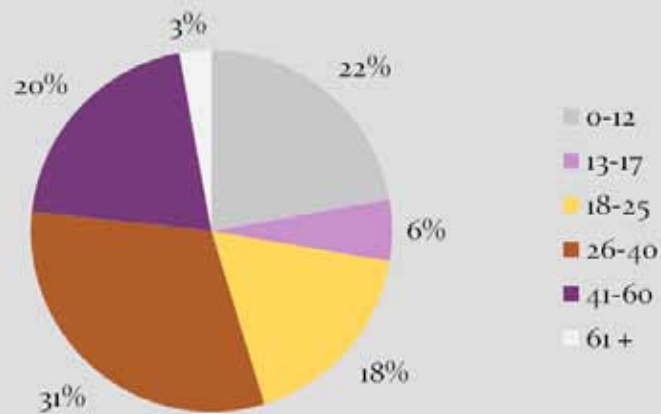

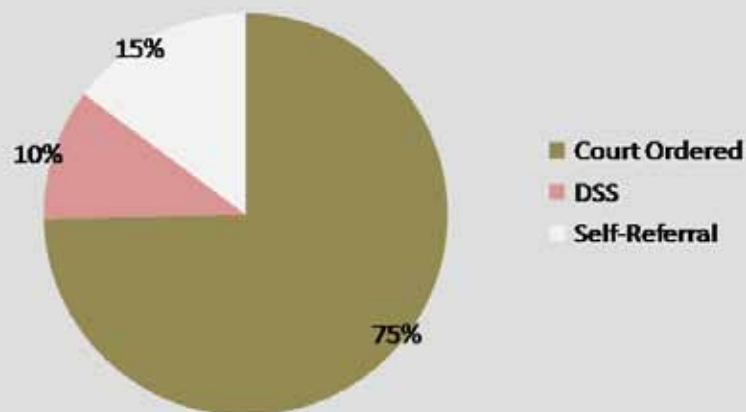
Domestic Violence Statistics
